PHOENIX COLLECTION LEATHER BELT PANELS CARE AND MAINTENANCE

The care for your belt panel is minimal and depends on the use. Your belt panel will carry the characteristics of the environment and the lifestyle of the area in which it is installed. It will develop both character and patina over time. Normal maintenance includes, vacuuming with a soft brush, damp mopping with a very well wrung out terrycloth.

- Dust-mop (with a non-treated, clean mop) or vacuum regularly to remove loose soil and fine dust particles that can scratch the finish;
- Wipe up spills quickly with a cloth or sponge and clean as recommended;
- As required, in addition to a damp cloth/mop, you may use Bona Hardwood Floor Cleaner, Swedish Formula, pH Neutral & Non-Toxic - a pH neutral cleaning product – on the leathers;
- Never use wet mops, highly acidic or alkaline cleaners, non-recommended commercial cleaners or polishes, or treated mops that have been used to clean other floors or furniture.
- Once installed, our Phoenix Leather Belt Panels don't require additional maintenance.
- Use shoe polish to repair any deep scratches or cuts as required.
- To help minimize expansion and contraction, use a humidifier or dehumidifier to maintain an even level of humidity. The recommended humidity range for all EcoDomo floors is 40% to 60%.

The care and maintenance for EcoDomo leathers products is very similar to the maintenance and requirements of interior wood finishes.
